## Jesus' first miracle

## The wedding at Cana

John 2:1-12 (New Revised Standard Version)

On the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there.

2 Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding. 3 When the wine gave out, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine." 4 And Jesus said to her, "Woman, what concern is that to you and to me? My hour has not yet come."

5 His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you."

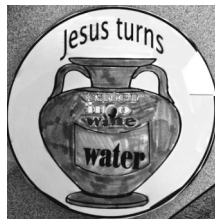
6 Now standing there were six stone water jars for the Jewish rites of purification, each holding twenty or thirty gallons. 7 Jesus said to them, "Fill the jars with water." And they

filled them up to the brim. 8 He said to them, "Now draw some out, and take it to the chief steward." So they took it. 9 When the steward tasted the water that had become wine, and did not know where it came from (though the servants who had drawn the water knew), the steward called the bridegroom 10 and said to him, "Everyone serves the good wine first, and then the inferior wine after the guests have become drunk. But you have kept the good wine until now." 11 Jesus did this, the first of his signs, in Cana of Galilee, and revealed his glory; and his disciples believed in him.



## Today's activities

1. **Water or wine cards.** Draw and colour a picture of a Jewish water jar then cut a hole to see what's inside - a rotating card on the back can show blue water or red wine!



2. **Mould a mini water jar.**

Use modelling clay to make a mini version of the huge jars that Jesus told the servants at the wedding to fill with water.



3. **Jesus' First Miracle**

**Banner.** Create a banner by colouring and sticking to leave in the church to remind us of Jesus' first miracle, turning water into wine.



4. **For the little ones**

Free play up by the altar .

5. **More coffee and cake at the Café tables**

## Our theme for this year -

### The miracles of Jesus

Last year at Café Church we focussed on Old Testament Superheroes. This year we are coming back fairly and squarely into the New Testament to follow Jesus in the 3 or 4 years of his ministry, by exploring the miracles that he performed.

We start with what is seen as his first miracle when he was attending a wedding at Cana in Galilee. When the wine ran out, Mary, his mother, asked him to help in order to avoid a terrible embarrassment for the host. Although Jesus told her that his time had not yet come, he did accede to her request and the wedding celebrations were saved and continued with copious quantities of the best quality wine.

Although Jesus also performed another miracle concerning food at the feeding of the five thousand, most of his miracles involved healing the sick, the troubled and the disabled, and we will learn about many of these stories over the course of the year.

How many of Jesus' miracles can you think of? We have a list of 37 which you can find spread throughout the four gospels of St Matthew, St Mark, St Luke and St John, and they involve people of all ages, origins and ranks. Jesus cares for everyone.
